Health and Dental Plans Survey

The Standing Committee on Insured Benefits (SCIB) is conducting a survey of the Government of New Brunswick Health and Dental plans. The purpose of this survey is to identify opportunities to better align plan design decisions with the needs and desires of retirees and their families, while ensuring that costs remain affordable.

SCIB has retained an independent benefit consulting firm (Luedey Consultants Inc.) who will be receiving responses and tabulating results. The survey is being hosted on a third-party platform (SimpleSurvey) and is intended to be completed anonymously in order to ensure confidentiality.

The survey is now open and will accept responses until February 23rd, 2024. All retirees are encouraged to participate in this survey, including those who do not currently participate in the benefit plans. All responses are confidential and only aggregate information will be shared with SCIB.
